

Episode 18

Ribbon Bookmark



Approx. Craft Time: 30 minutes
Skill Level: 1 (1 being the easiest)
Yield: 1 bookmark

Tip

Be sure, when choosing your ribbon, that you match your clamp to the width of the ribbon. Cut ribbon will fray if the clamp is smaller than the ribbon.

Materials List

- Celebrate It™ red velvet 5/8" ribbon
- Jewelry Essentials silver ribbon clamps
- Bead Gallery® 8mm green crackle bicone beads
- Bead Gallery® 8mm round red coral beads
- Lost & Found™ metal charms: love/laugh
- Jewelry Essentials 7mm silver jump rings
- Jewelry Essentials connector head pins, 2", silver
- Needle-nose jewelry pliers

Step 1

Cut 8" length of ribbon.

Step 2

Place one end of ribbon between the ribbon clamp. Be sure to use the appropriate size clamp for your width of ribbon. Use needle-nose pliers to clamp closed, holding the ribbon in place. Repeat on opposite end.

Step 3

Attach charms to end of ribbon clamp with a small jump ring.

Step 4

Use head pin for dangles. Place green bicone bead on to pin. Add red bead.

Step 5

Bend head pin at end of bead to a 90 degree angle. Cut pin leaving ¼ inch.

Step 6

Use needle-nose pliers to bend pin back around to make loop. Attach loop to end of ribbon clamp.
